





- £1.5bn funding over 2015-2021

We have set out a timetable to 2030



Taxi measures

- **£20m Ultra Low Emission Taxi** Infrastructure Scheme
- £50m Plug-in Taxi grant that offers up to £7.5k off the cost of a new purpose built vehicle
- Upcoming exemption of premium rate VED for new zero emission capable taxis



£40m to establish Go Ultra Low Cities
